# Rehabilitation centre for DMD patients inaugurate

The centre will provide free treatment, says director

COIMBATORE: The first model rehabilitation centre in Tamil Nadu for patients of 'Duchenne Muscular Dystrophy (DMD),' a rare incurable genetic disorder that fatally affects children as young as three years, was inaugurated in the city on Saturday. The centre will be run by Molecular Diagnostics, Counselling, Care and Research Centre (MDCRC) and is located at Kurunji Hospital.

According to the Centre's Director B.R. Lakshmi, it will begin providing free treatment. It had also arranged a vehicle that had been customised to transport children with DMD along with their attenders as well.

She emphasised the need for integrated rehabilitation services for the children affected with DMD, based on Ayurveda, yoga and physio-
